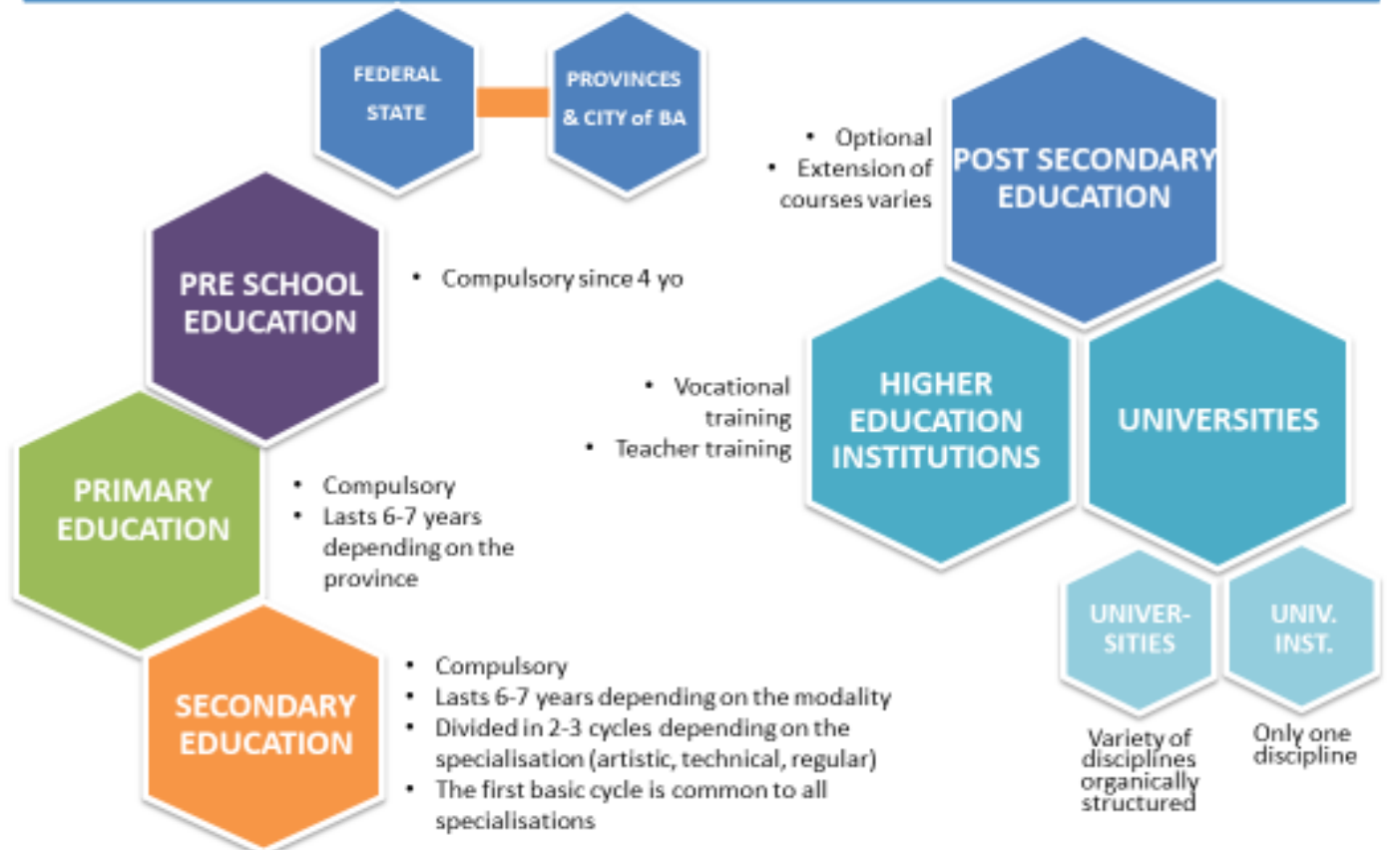

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT H.E. IN ARGENTINA

H.E. IN ARGENTINA: TWO DISTINCT SETS OF INSTITUTIONS:

A- UNIVERSITIES AND UNIVERSITY INSTITUTES , which focuses on the training of specialized professionals, scientists, and academics;

●B- HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTES , dedicated to technical-vocational and teacher training.

●Although both subsystems are a part of the higher education field in Argentina, they do not share common origins with regard to history and production conditions.

●As a result, each subsystem's relationship with the State is different, and so are the characteristics of their communities (teachers as well as students, in relation to social, economic, and cultural sectors of origin) and their institutional culture.



- **In the university sector, students are primarily enrolled at public institutions - 79 percent of students attended public institutions in 2016**
- Private HEIs are mostly smaller institutions located in urban centers. While 25 percent of students in Buenos Aires and the Central Region were enrolled in private HEIs, private enrollments in the Southern Region made up only 6 percent of the student population.
- Eighty-one percent of private institutions have less than 10,000 students, while the majority of public institutions enroll more than 10,000 students with big national universities having student enrollments above 100,000.

ACCESS AND INCLUSION IN H.E. ARGENTINA

- Education is a Human Right, Public Good, State Duty (CRES-UNESCO 2008/2018)
- Free of charge for undergraduate level. GRATUITY (Fees por master and same PHDs)
- Low % of foreing students, less than 5 % of the total enrolled student.
- Admission to Higher Education All secondary school graduates who hold a *Bachiller* or *Tecnico* are legally entitled to enroll at a public university.
- Preparatory programs help promote equal opportunities by equalizing student preparation among students from socially disadvantaged families or under-performing provinces. Universities therefore have established prep-programs also with the aim to ensure that promotion and graduation rates are not dependent on the place of origin or [socioeconomic background](#).

- We recommend to book via AirB&B or similar for the first days in Buenos Aires, do NOT book long-stay until you arrive and see the housing offered. Be aware of fraudulent housing opportunities.
