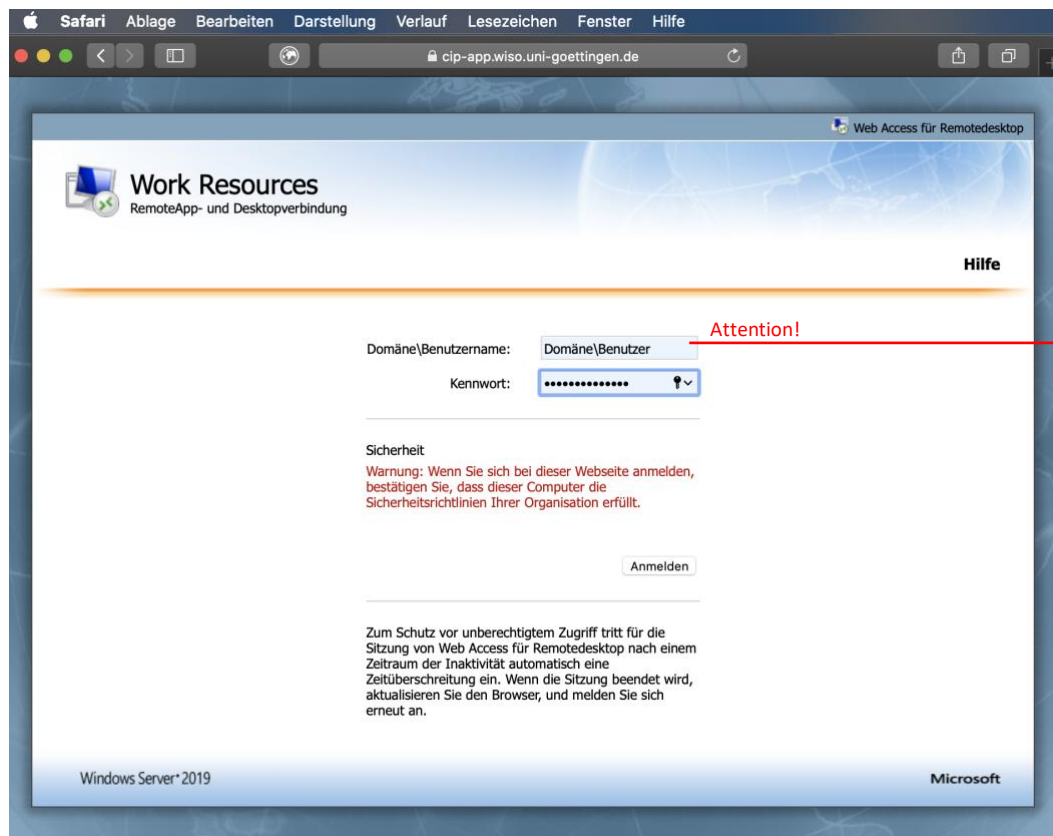

Establishment connection with Safari

To get connected with the remote desktop app is an existing VPN connection required. Instructions can be found on the GWDG website:

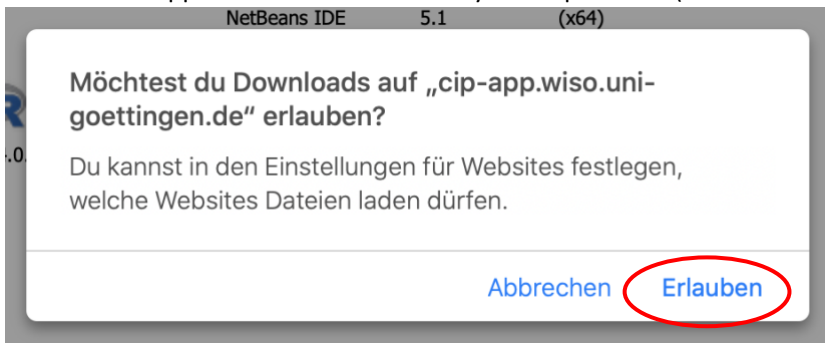
For the login you have to use **GWDG\username** or **UG-STUDENT\username** and your **password**. (UG-STUDENT and GWDG are the unlocked domains for the Access. Only the username does not work!)

Establishment connection with Safari

You will be forwarded to the following window:

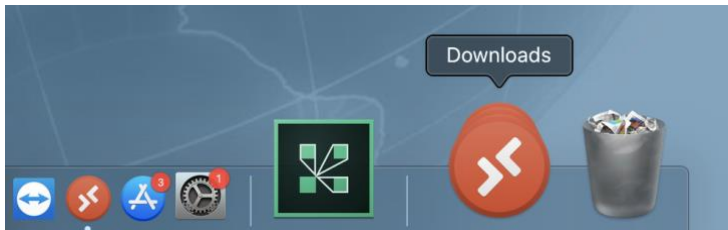


The remote-app will be downloaded by a simple click (**no double click**) on the desired application.

Download folder in the **dock**:

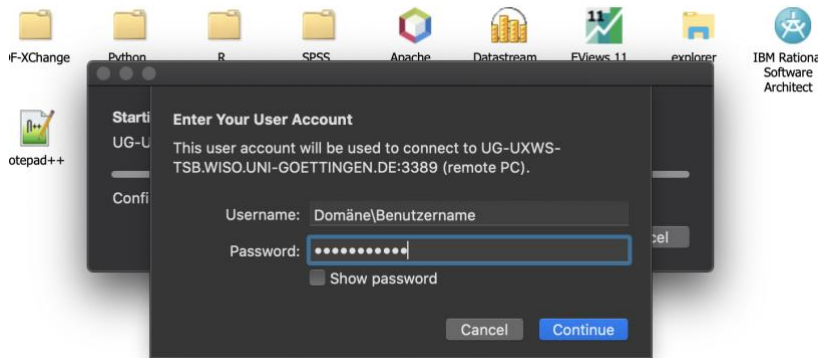


Open the downloaded **.rdp** file:



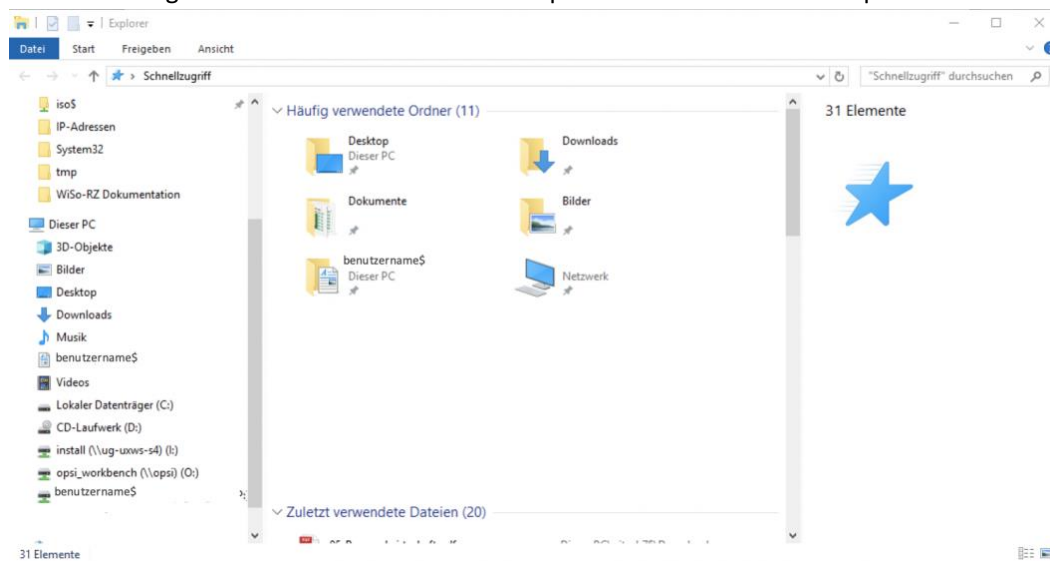

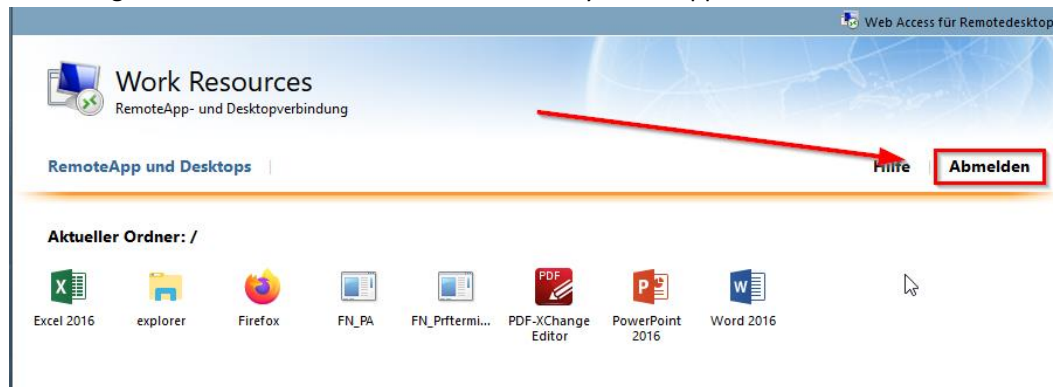

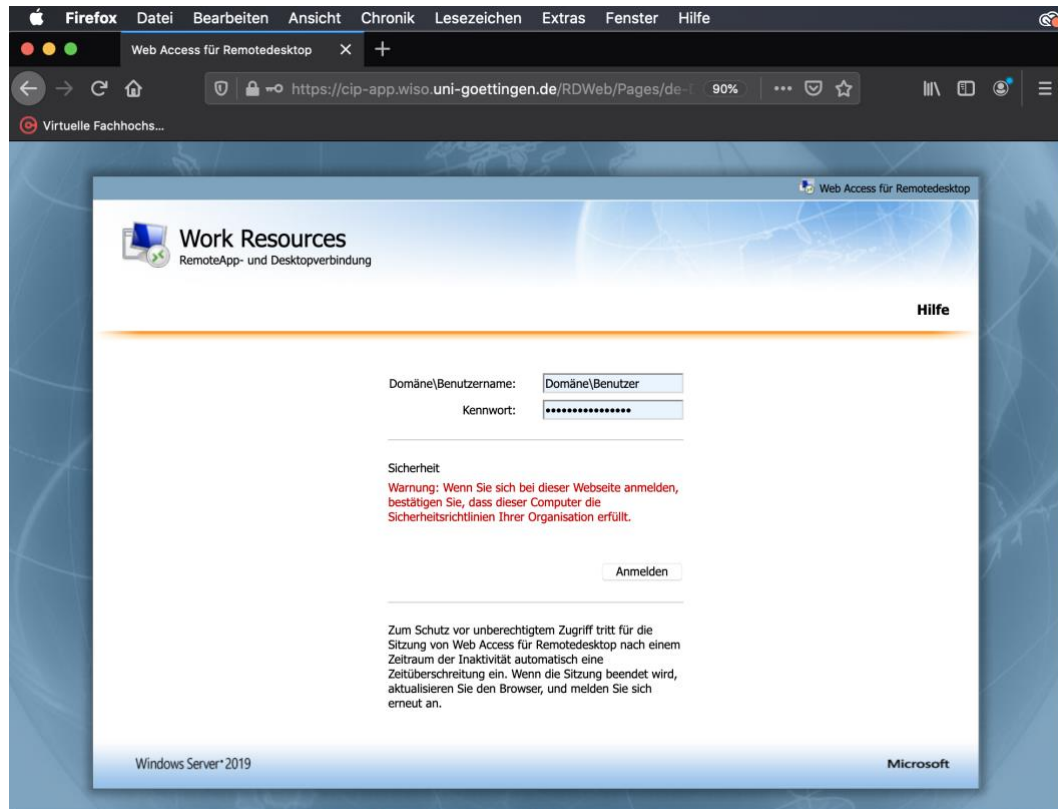

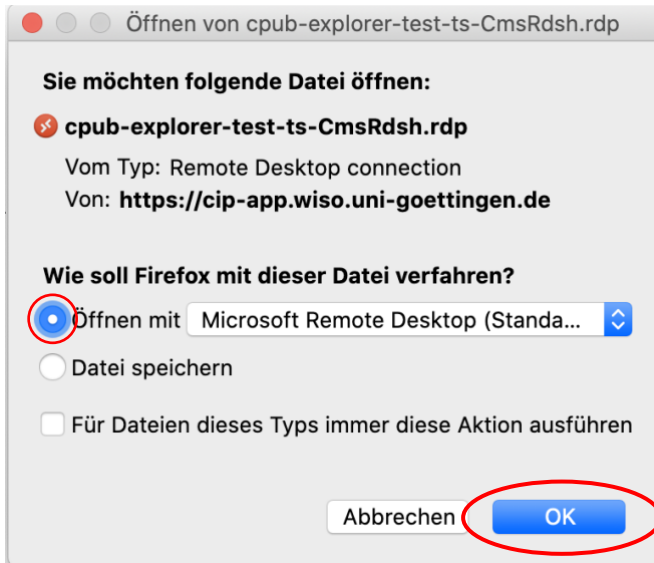

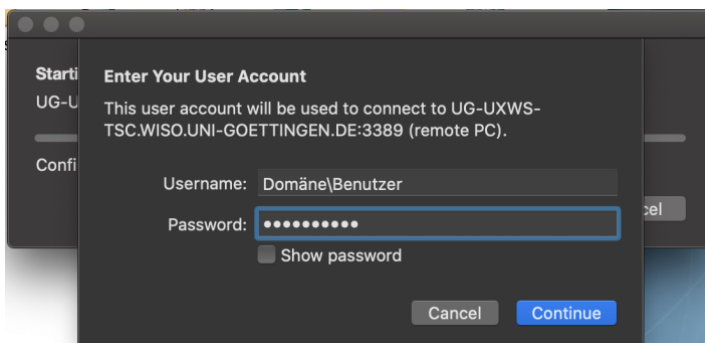
A simple click (no double click) on an application will open the following window:

Open the .rdp file by confirming

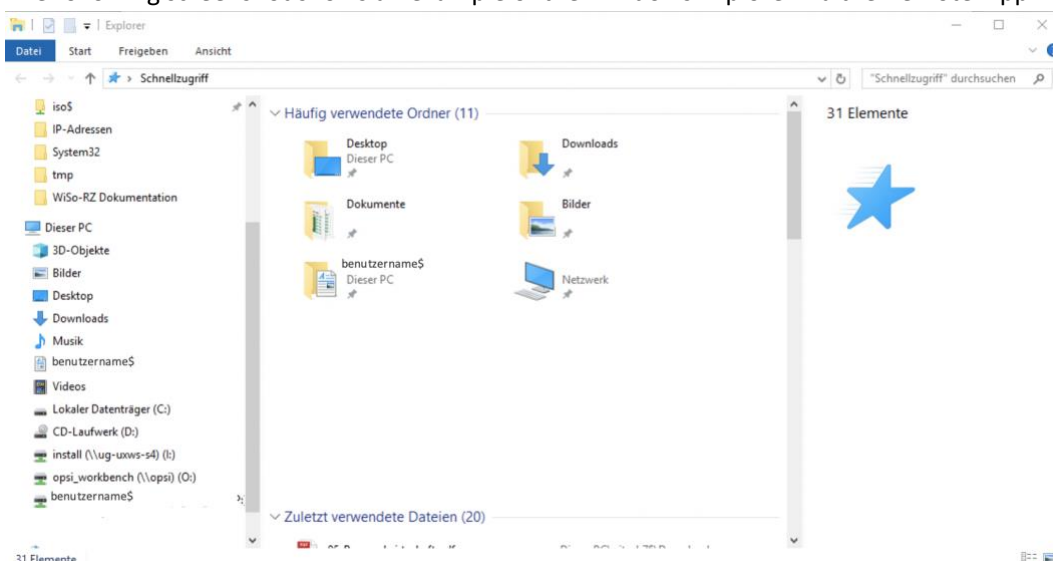

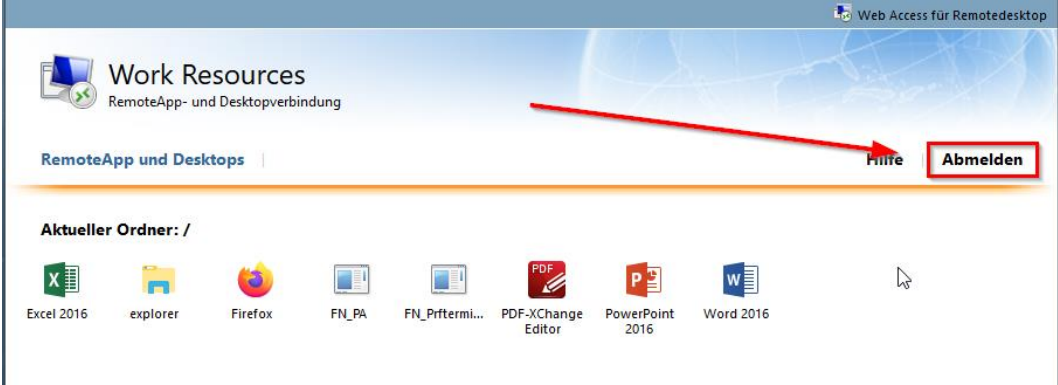

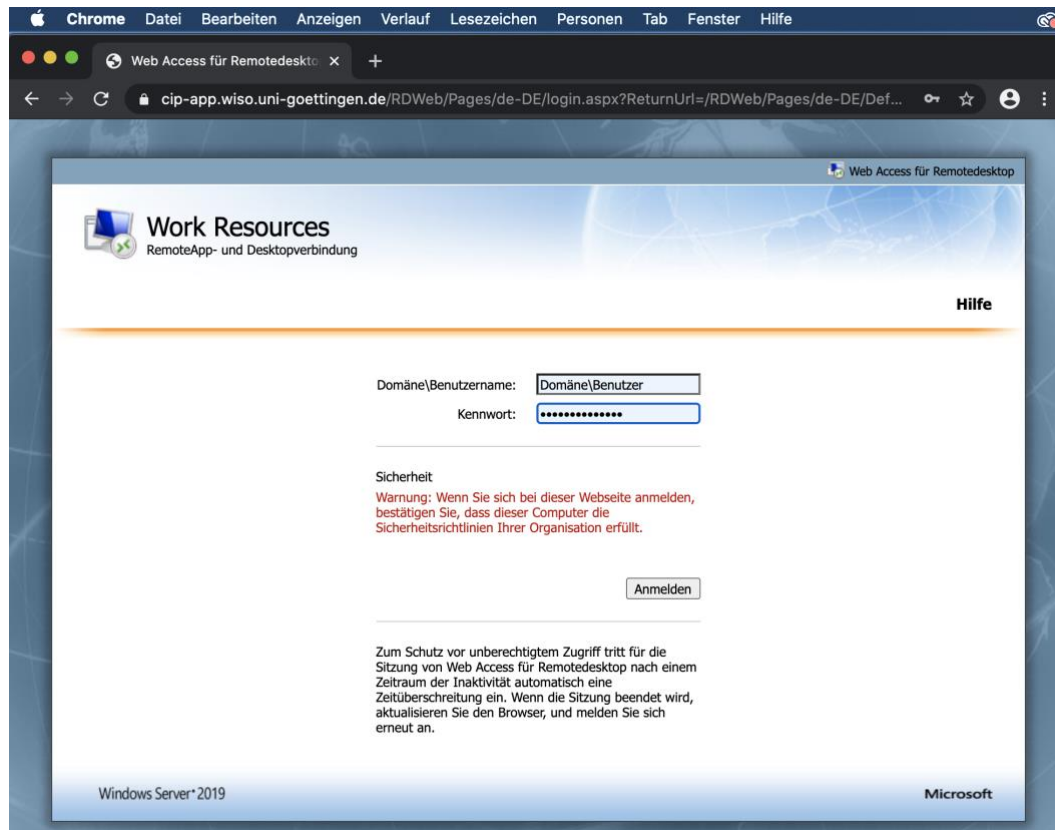

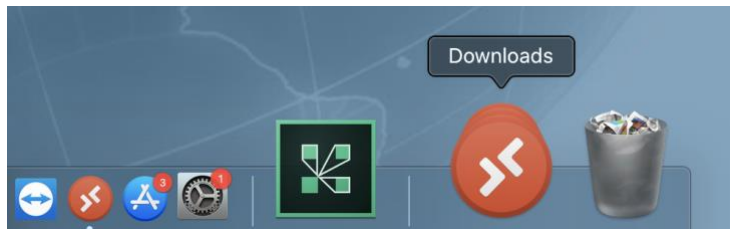


Establishment connection with Google Chrome

The application can now be opened directly from the Google Chrome download bar or alternatively can be found in the local download folder in the Dock:

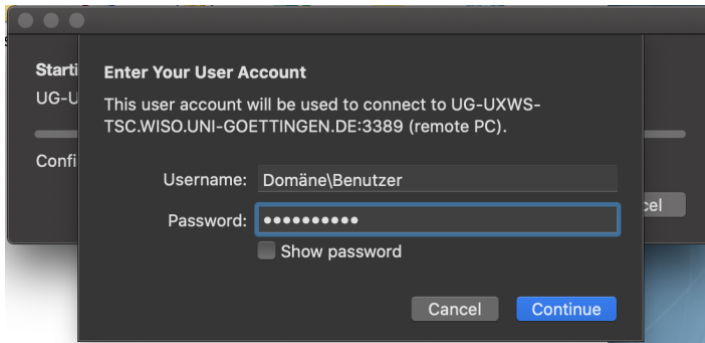


Open the downloaded .rdp file:



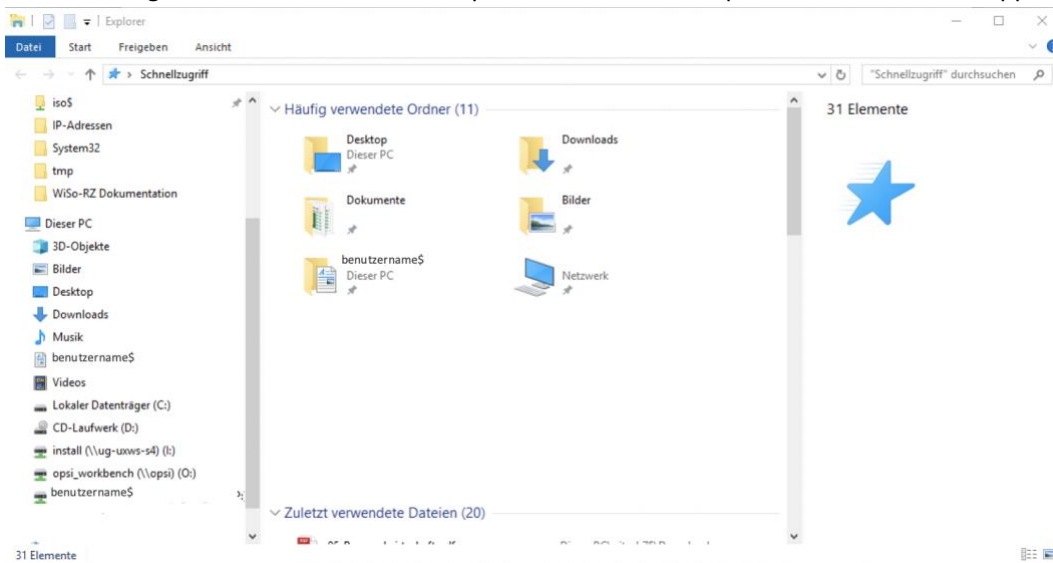

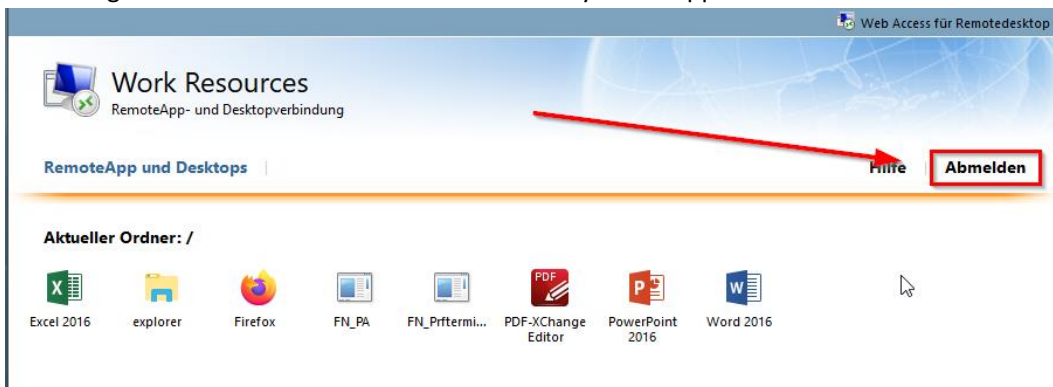

To be able to access your local folders while using the remote desktop apps, you can integrate them like the following:

Select "Preferences" and "General" go to the option "If folder redirection is enabled [...]" "Choose Folder"
There you are able to select the folder that you also want to access from the server.
