This interdisciplinary U4 Summer School in Gender Studies for PhD and Advanced MA students is organized by the working group on Gender within the U4 network. U4 is a strategic partnership between Ghent University (BE), the University of Göttingen (DE), the University of Groningen (NL), and Uppsala University (S). It is based on well-established, previously existing, bilateral agreements between the partner universities.
