The ancient Roman Amphitheater, built at some point between the first and second century A.D. Forged from the rocks which constitute the natural landscape of the island, this amphitheater was the scene of gladiatorial combat before becoming, in recent times, an invaluable cultural space used principally for drama and the performing arts.

The Botanical Garden of Cagliari, founded by the celebrated botanist Patrizio Gennari, are home to a wide variety of native and exotic plants. Here you will also be able to enter and explore the ancient aqueduct built by the Carthaginians and latterly The Romans.
